CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- Points will be awarded as per GCR's to all Full Financial Members of Lightweight Motorcycle Club Inc.
- One Day Members will not be allocated points towards the Club Championships.
- Members will need to attend the Presentation Day to for collection of Club Championship Trophies.

SCORING

- Scoring will be as per GCR's.
- Riders will be responsible for entry into correct classes at machine examination and will only be scored for those classes signed on and paid for.
- Riders will only received points for the class/es they nominate for at each club run.
- **RACE NUMBERS MUST BE DISPLAYED CORRECTLY OR YOU WILL NOT BE SCORED.**

SIGN-ON

Will take place at Machine Examination Shed.

All Riders must present themselves with:

- MA license
- Proof of current club membership to Race Secretary.

RACE SECRETARY AND ASSISTANT ONLY TO COMPLETE SIGN-ON SHEET AND THE RIDER OR IF UNDER 18 YEARS, PARENT/GUARDIAN TO SIGN AND PAY FEES.

NOTE:

If you are under the age of 18 and a parent can not be present for the day's event, you are required to have parent/guardian consent to appoint guardianship for the day's event. The parent and guardian **MUST** complete the form and the guardian must be present for the day's event. The Form is to be given to the Race Secretary and without this documentation you will not be permitted to ride.

Junior wanting to ride on a One Event licence must have evidences they have completed the Log Book for the 5 hours coaching before the event.

FLAGS

Each family will be required to do flag duty as required at club runs. In addition, you may be asked to assist with other duties such as scoring, canteen, gates etc. A rider's representative who is required to do flag duties must sign on at machine examination. If you do not sign on or do not provide a rider's representative, you will be excluded from practice and competition unless just cause can be proven to the Steward of the day.

MACHINE EXAMINATION

Pits will open 7.00am

Machine examination from 7.00am to 8.30am

- All competitors must present themselves with their bike and riding gear for inspection.
- Any machine not presented with all of the above requirements will be rejected!!
- ALL MACHINES MUST CONFORM TO THE GCR'S
